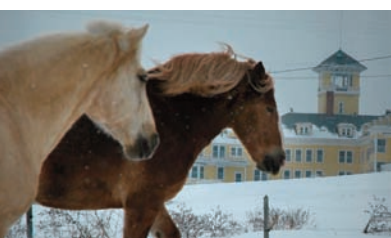

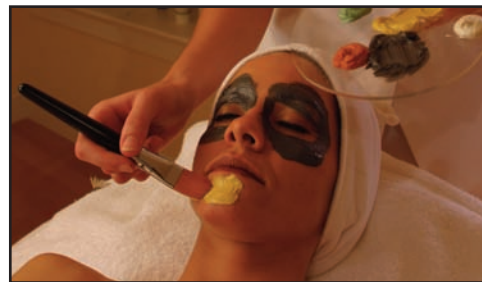

RESORT ACTIVITIES



Bicycling

Whether you take a ride on a full-suspension mountain bike or a hybrid, guests are sure to find a wealth of riding opportunities in the area. Experiences meet the vitality and skill levels of all. From gentle country roads, to our on-site bike trail, and heart-pounding, lift-serviced terrain, we can assist you in designing the ultimate day of outdoor exploration. Boating

New Hampshire's many lakes, rivers, and ponds provide a wealth of recreational opportunities for boating, swimming and fishing. The state maintains a number of public boat launches and beaches for boat owners and requires all power boats in New Hampshire waters to be registered in the state. Carriage Rides

Cuddle up and take a ride down peaceful Mountain View Road in our custom-made horse carriage. Book in advance by visiting the Front Desk. Rides are \$65 for 30 minutes for up to five people.

Children's Playground

Children's Recreation Program

We're proud to offer the Mountain View Mountaineering Club, operating from Memorial Day through Labor Day. The complimentary program promises a fun-filled agenda of stimulating activities for young people ages 4-12 throughout the summer. Qualified counselors supervise children in small groups that never exceed the ratio of six children per counselor.

Croquet

The game of croquet has maintained its popularity at Mountain View Grand Resort & Spa for more than a hundred years, as the ideal complement to garden parties, family gatherings, outdoor fundraisers, and elegant social events. Please contact the Club House for equipment.

Cross Country Skiing

The pristine splendor of New England is beautifully showcased by these tranquil surroundings. The Activities Department, at extension 7470, can provide you with rental equipment and assist you in selecting the best trail, many of which begin right from our Activity Center.

Fly-Casting Clinics

Guests can learn the basic fly-casting techniques from instructor Neil Beaulieu right on Mountain View Grand grounds. The clinic runs for one hour on Thursday and Saturday and is \$25.00 per person for ages 7 and up. The clinic has a maximum number of six participants, so sign up with the concierge early.

Geo-Caching Adventure

Guests use hand-held GPS units to locate various caches around the property. Participants should be prepared to get a little muddy, climb over various trail obstacles, and have a fabulous time exploring our 1,700 acres. \$5 per person. For liability purposes, credit card information must be obtained at the time of reservation. Sign up with the concierge.

Golf

Our challenging 100-year-old mountain golf course was given a professional design in 1936, by Ralph Barton, the renowned golf architect. The course was renovated in 1999, when extensive work to the greens, teeing areas, and course hazards allowed it to recapture its original grandeur. The course is situated on our beautiful country hillside, affording fabulous views of four distinct mountain ranges. The rating for men is 67.3 and for women 71.9, while the slope of the course is 112. Total men's yardage is 2,873 for nine holes and 5,318 for eighteen holes. Total women's yardage is 2,659 for nine holes and 5,318 for eighteen holes. Our Pro Shop staff will be happy to reserve tee times within 72 hours of play.

Health & Wellness Center

Open 365 days a year from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m., the Health & Wellness Center is equipped with new, state-of-the-art Techno Gym equipment that includes treadmills, ellipticals, stair machines, stationary bikes, and a variety of lifting machines. Functional training equipment is also available. Peter Camann, our personal trainer, is available by appointment and offers several classes including AquaLogix, a pool-based fitness class. The center includes an indoor pool, hot tub, sauna, and men's and women's locker rooms with showers and changing areas.

Hiking

Located in one of the most geographically stunning regions of the United States and set on 1,700 acres with sweeping panoramic views, Mountain View Grand Resort & Spa offers more than just a walk in the woods. Groomed trails meander throughout wooded glades and charming open fields. The White Mountains are a part of the Appalachian Trail system – home to a number of peaks with well-maintained trails. Our knowledgeable and friendly Guest Services staff can offer advice about property trails and local day-hikes. Ask for information at the Front Desk or see the Concierge.

Ice Skating

Lace up your skates and take a cruise around our rink, which is located next to the Activity Center. Ask our staff about skate rentals.

Moose Tours

Guests can explore The Great North Woods looking for moose in a 12-passenger van. Moose Tours last two hours and explore paved and dirt roads throughout the region. A minimum of 5 people per tour is required; tours are \$25.00 per person. Please sign up with the concierge.

Mountain View Farm

The farm, located in our big red barn, provides a learning experience for visitors of all ages. Kids can get up close and personal with our friendly miniature donkeys, goats, sheep, chickens, llamas, and pigs during interactive "Meet the Farmer" sessions.

Shuffleboard

Another favorite pastime from a more leisurely era, the Shuffleboard court is located at the Club House. Arrange court times and reserve equipment by calling extension 7470.

Snowmobile Rentals

Access to New Hampshire's renowned Corridor 5 provides Mountain View Grand snowmobile enthusiasts with more than 50 continuous miles of trails. Please contact the Activity Center at extension 7470 to arrange rentals and guided tours.

Snowshoeing

The cross-country ski trails share access with snowshoeing enthusiasts. Visit the Activity Center or call extension 7470 for trail maps, information and rentals.

Tee off on Mountain View Grand's historic nine-hole golf course. Challenge yourself on fairways that meander around the hotel with ever-changing views of the White Mountains.

This challenging course was designed and built in 1900, by Ralph Barton, a professor of Mathematics at Dartmouth College and a renowned golf architect of the early 20th Century. The course was renovated in 1999, and again in 2006 and 2007, with extensive work to the greens, tee boxes and course hazards.



The golf course is open seven days a week from May to October. For more information or to reserve a tee time call 603.837.0076.
